Flight Surgeon's Report of Aircraft Accident (continued)

Jones, James H. Jr. (cont'd) with multiple ribs fractured (region of 7th to 11th). Contusion (severe) of left iliac region(no fracture found). Skull fracture and crushing of left chest fatal.

Conrad, George J. Abrasion and contusion of scalp. Contusion - back, level of 4th L.V. Contusions - both knees. Abrasion - 3ml. palmar surface, left hand.

Jenkins, John E. Several small abrasions palmar surface left hand. Contusion lateral surface left thigh. Strain - Lumbo - sacral, left, mild. Abrasions - both legs. Contusion, lateral surface right arm.


Lemons, Ray L. Bruise, right ankle. Linear abrasion, 1 inch palmar surface, right hand. Three small abrasions right knee. Two small abrasions left shoulder. Boutusion over Coccyx. Abrasion, 1 inch, occipital region of head. X-Ray of right ankle negative.

Dixon, Brendan Abrasion of scalp, left ear, face, rt wrist. Contusion of lip. Abrasions of left shoulder, fingers, hands. Abrasions of both legs . X-Ray of skull - negative.

Huntington, Harry E. Linear superficial abrasion dorsum of left wrist and hand, 3 inch. Abrasion 1 cm. dorsum, left thumb. Abrasion 1/2 inch, lateral surface, left knee. Contusion of left hip. Abrasion 0.5cm. above left eyebrow. Linear abrasion, 1 inch, rt temporal region.

Autopsy Findings - Lt James H. Jones . Blood clot in optic nerve. Puncture of left lung by fractured ribs. Puncture of liver and left kidney.
