## ATTU SHIVERS AS WIND REACHES 125

Buffeted and battered by blinding gales Attu emerged today from her first storm of the year, with no casualties reported and in good condition.

A. H. Hodges, Aerm. 2/c, of the Island's aereology station reported the following facts on Wednesday's storm. Blowing from the north, the winds averaged 59 knots with occasional gusts reaching 95 knots. As this end of the Island is sheltered somewhat, the Army weather station had the hardest winds to report. Their instrument records winds reaching 125 miles per hour, and the noddie was pushing this several times during the storm.

Height of the rampage of nature was reached at 0800, at which time visibility and ceiling were absolute zero. Temperature of the storm at its height was 22 degrees above zero. Coldest temperature recorded was 18 which was taken several hours after the storm had passed.
